Ephesians 1

Prayer for Spiritual Wisdom

15 Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, 16 do not cease to give thanks for _____, making mention of ____ in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to _____ the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of _____ understanding being enlightened; that ____ may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what *is* the exceeding greatness of His power toward ____ who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated *Him* at His right hand in the heavenly *places*, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

22 And He put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* head over all *things* to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all

Ephesians 3

14 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,^[c] 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 that He would grant _____, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, 17 that Christ may dwell in _____ heart(s) through faith; that _____, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that _____ may be filled with all the fullness of God.

20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 21 to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
